Class Change Carousel

During the afternoon of **Monday, the 11**th **July**, the children will be meeting their Class Teachers for the next academic year. This year it is necessary to re-shuffle several of our year groups into three different classes. As described in our brochure, being a large three form entry primary, we embrace every professional opportunity to ensure there is an inclusive balance of the following across all three classes especially when new children have joined us during the year:

- Gender
- Prior Attainment
- Particular strengths, skills, talents and interests
- Additional Special Educational Needs and Disabilities
- Safeguarding Child Protection priorities

Whilst transition can be eased by the preservation of some friendship groups, there can also sometimes be a need to consider negative preferences from parents. Occasionally the requests received can be mutually exclusive and, therefore, awkward to negotiate in our attempts to keep them confidential. Thankfully, irrespective of their learning peers, children will have access to their friends in social groups during breaks throughout the school day. Thank you in advance for your understanding of the professional decisions made at this time, the information about the Class Teacher for your child next year will be sent in a separate letter.
