Challenge of the Week

<u>Density</u>

Some liquids are **denser** than others (more **mass** in the same volume).

How can we test that the mass is greater when the volume is the same?

Take a fresh egg and place it in a glass of water. What happens? Remove the egg and add 2 tablespoons of salt and mix until **dissolved**. What happens?

Does the egg float? How much salt needs to be added

before the egg floats? When the egg floats, it is

because you have made the water dense enough!
